Sadness is a very normal human reaction to an external happening: your goldfish dies, you feel sad. That's normal. With clinical depression however, feelings become totally out of proportion to the external cause, and persist. In fact, many people who suffer from depression are devoid of any happy or sad feelings whatsoever. Instead, they feel what is often described as 'an emptiness' or 'numbness' which makes them question the point of living It's not just about having theblues at all.

Learn these signs for your own safety and for the safety of others.


